



## Springfield High School Ice Hockey Code of Conduct

### RULES FOR PARENT / PLAYER / SPECTATOR CONDUCT SPRINGFIELD HIGH SCHOOL ICE HOCKEY LEAGUE AND NON-LEAGUE COMPETITION

All parents, players and spectators will conduct themselves in an orderly, sportsmanlike and professional manner when attending an ICSHL League or Non-League game. Any report of disorderly conduct in the rink, parking lot, etc. including but not limited to the following will not be tolerated.

- Parents going on the ice.
- Parents going into the referees' locker room or opposing team's locker room.
- Physical abuse of referees, coaches, players or rink employees.
- Verbal abuse of the above participants, to the point of obscene, racial, ethnic or sexual slurs.
- Fighting among parent or spectators in the stands.
- Any problem with crowd control that results in the summoning of police.
- Any issues that are not covered above that result in loss of control by a parent, player or spectator.

All reports given to the ICSHL by referees, rink management or either of the participating organizations, or observed by members of the SHS Hockey Board of Directors that involve SHS Hockey members, parents, or supporters will be reviewed by SHS Hockey Board of Directors which can recommend the following actions, and specify the duration of any suspensions.

- Suspension of parents, players or spectators involved in any altercation. Parents, players or spectators cannot attend any future games for the duration of the suspension decided by the SHS Hockey Board of Directors.
- If a parent does not abide by the rulings, the Club will suspend the parent's child from further play until the parent does abide.
- Any suspended party reinstated after petition, involved in another altercation will be expelled from the Club and cannot attend games for the balance of the hockey season.
- After any party's expulsion from the Club, the SHS Hockey Board of Directors will require a petition and a hearing before this party or their child will not be permitted to register with the Club for a following season.
- The SHS Hockey Board of Directors will review all recommended disciplinary actions with the school Athletic Director and will secure the school district's support and authority for these actions.

Referees are authorized the USA Hockey to utilize ZERO Tolerance standards when addressing spectators and issuing reports on the same.

The Clubs in the Atlantic District and our league are expected to monitor their teams, including their parents and players. These rules, while harsh are expected to weed out the problems in each organization, since these parents, players and spectators cannot control themselves and will certainly test the system.
